3. Bidding will be conducted through National Competitive Bidding (NCB) procedures specified in the National Public Procurement Act 2016 and is open to all eligible bidders as defined in the manual and Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers July 2016 Revised November 2017 to November 2020.

The bidding document may be purchased by interested eligible Bidders upon the submission of a written application to the address below and upon payment of a non-refundable fee of Two Million Leones (NLe2,000) and bidders may obtain further information on the bidding document at the address below between 11:00 am to 4:00pm from Mondays to Fridays no-later than five (5) days prior to the deadline of submission of bids. The method of payment will be cash.

6. All Bids must be accompanied by a Bid Security in the amounts indicated above or its equivalent in a freely convertible currency. The Bidder shall seal the original and each copy of the bid, in separate envelopes, duly marking the envelopes as “ORIGINAL (1)” and “COPY (3).” The envelopes shall then be enclosed in an outer envelope and sealed.

7. All bids must be accompanied by:

- Valid copy of NRA tax certificate;
- Valid NASSIT Clearance Certificate.
- Valid certificates of business registration;
- Business Profile of the Supplier/Service Provider

8. Bids must be delivered to the address below on or before 11:00 a.m. on Friday 20th January, 2023. Electronic Bidding will *not* be permitted. Late Bids will be rejected.
