All envelopes marked "**SECOND ENVELOPE: FINANCIAL PART**" shall remain unopened and will be held in safe custody of the Purchaser until the second public opening.
- 7. All Bids must be accompanied by a Bid Security in the amounts indicated above or its equivalent in a freely convertible currency.
